RE: NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 53(1) OF THE PROMOTION OF ACCESS TO INFORMATION ACT 2 OF 2000 (THE ACT)

Your no ce in terms of Sec on 53(1) of the Promo on of Access to Informa on Act 2 of 2000 (the Act) refers.

SAPREF followed its internal governance and due diligence processes to properly assess the nature of the informa on requested in order to make an informed and fair decision on the request.

At the outset, it must be reiterated that SAPREF operates as a Crude Oil Re nery at its plant in Prospecton, and regards its business as highly specialized in nature. SAPREF is therefore duty bound to protect its con den al informa on since failure to do so has the potential of causing substantial harm to SAPREF's business.

A er an extensive internal exercise reviewing the requested informa on, SAPREF responds to the request as follows:

a) Copy of SAPREF's Atmospheric Emission License

SAPREF refuses the request for access to this informa on. This being so since SAPREF considers the informa on to contain:

- Trade secrets of SAPREF; and
- Financial, commercial, scien c and / or technical informa on other than trade secrets, where the disclosure thereof would be likely to cause harm to the commercial or nancial interests of SAPREF; and
- Disclosure of SAPREF informa on could put SAPREF at a disadvantage in nego a ons or commercial compe on;

Moreover, SAPREF does not consider the informa on contained in the AEL to be:

- · Publicly available;
- Concerning informa on the disclosure of which would reveal a serious public safety or environmental risk.



SAPREF and ENGEN AEL'S

Please note that we sent out section 47 notices to both ENGEN and SAPREF dated 04 June and requested them both to respond by the 12th of June which they have done. The Act specifies that before we can attend to your application we need to obtain approval or objection from SAPREF and ENGEN. SAPREF and ENGEN have both opted to exercise their rights in terms of Section 47 (e) of the Act and require a further 21 days in order to follow their own internal processes. This office has today acknowledged their request and asked them to provide responses by the 21st June 2013. Thereafter we will require further consultation, depending on the response by both parties, with our Legal Advisor and the Environmental Health Department.

It is hereby recommended that to ensure due process is followed and to enable us to respond, that a further extension of time to resolve this application be given. The matter will therefore be extended to the 26th July 2013.
